SCHOOL CONTEXT

The Dell Primary School is situated in the centre of the town of Chepstow which is in the south eastern corner of Monmouthshire, which is our Local Education Authority (LEA). It serves the local area, which is largely residential and relatively prosperous. There are pupils on roll from the ages of four to eleven.

Nearly all pupils live relatively close to the school. 10% of pupil households are in Gloucestershire, England. Pupils have a full range of ability. When they start school in the reception class our children's skills and experiences are generally in line with those expected and found amongst four year olds. There are approx. 8% of pupils entitled to free school meals, which is well below the LEA average of 10.9% and the all-Wales average of 17.5%.

About 9% of pupils are considered by the school to have some degree of Additional Learning Need (ALN) which is below average for schools locally and nationally. One pupil is looked after by the LEA. Approximately 4% of pupils have English as an Additional Language. No pupil has Welsh as the first language of the home. The school was last inspected in June 2022. The Dell is one of five primary schools in the Chepstow Cluster of schools. Nearly all children join our Reception classes from one of five pre-school settings and nearly all pupils move on to Year 7 at Chepstow School.

School Security

The school's Health and Safety Policy provides much advice on the supervision of pupils, particularly at the start of the day and lunch times and break times when the pupils are outside. Amongst the measures adopted by the school are:

An internal fence controlling access to the playground and classrooms.

A security system on the main entrance door as well as Upper School and Early Years entrances and demountable building entrances preventing unauthorised access during the school day.

Halo signing in & out system

All visitors have to complete Halo sign in and wear a visitors badge.

Breakfast Club

We offer a free breakfast for pupils from 8am each school day. Breakfast Club is funded by Welsh Government specifically to ensure that every child can start their learning day in the best possible way. Breakfast Club provision starts at 8am and ends at 8.40am

After School Child Care

Our After School Club is run by Mathern Day Nursery and is available from 3.30pm until 6.00pm each school day.

Uniform

It is our wish that all children of The Dell Primary School wear school uniform. We know that the majority of parents find it convenient to have a school uniform. The Governors feel that the wearing of school uniform by all children promotes a smart, positive image of the school.
