Pupils have been applying their previously taught skills to theme related projects in their year groups. It has been wonderful to see our pupils engaged in their learning so enthusiastically. For example I've seen Year 1 working superbly on their MY TIME activities about Exploration. Our Year 4 pupil projects reflected their Journey Through Wales theme and Year 6 pupils produced some amazing independent work on their Culture Clash projects.

Over the last 6 weeks staff have engaged with parents and carers holding Parent and Teacher Consultations, RWI Workshops and an online survey to review our Trips, Visits and Events Calendar. Thank you if you participated in these important engagement activities.

This half term staff have worked hard in Professional Learning Meetings focusing on feedback and pupil progression during teaching sessions and further developing Welsh skills through games and group activities. These spaces now have Maths games and equipment, Literacy activities and building tools such as Kapla Blocks and Lego. We aim to make our outdoor provision consistent for all learners across the school.

I would like to thank all the staff for their hard work and dedication this half term. We have put in long hours to improve provision for our learners and meet with parents and carers. I would like to remind you all that we have a Sharing Afternoon for parents and carers on Friday 24th March. This will be another opportunity for you to visit classrooms and look at your child's books and work.
