Our class not only have split teaching for the third year in a row, the children inform us that their regular teacher is absent and the teaching assistants or substitute teacher has taken their class on a regular basis! We were assured that other responsibilities would not impact their presence in the classroom but this evidently isn't the case. PE lessons are cancelled at short notice on a regular basis particularly around Christmas time. Also my child was bullied but we were the ones pulled in to speak to the teacher on the playground – not the aggressor's parents.
